Eagan's Frenchie

MATERIALS:

Hook: TMC 3761 Sizes 12,14,16,18

Body: Peacock Hurl.

Rib: Small copper wire

Collar: Cream or tan sparkle dubbing (Wapsi Life cycle)

Tunsten Bead: sized to hook



HOW FISHED:

This fly can be fished as a dropper under another weighted fly such as a glow ball or under a dry fly. Some fish it as a single fly. All methods are very effective. Good Luck. Earl S.
