

**Fly of the Month**

**Brillar Chironimid Pupae Fly.**

Tied by Earl Schenberg: Fly tying Chariman



**MATERIAL LIST:**

Hook: TMC 2487, size 16-18

Thread: 8/0 black Uni thread

Bead: Tungsten black sz. 5/64

Body: Ice Dub, Holo olive green or peacock Use any olive reflective material

Gills: white Antron, trimmed

Ribbing: None necessary

**TYING INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Put bead on hook with large side forward.
2. Tie in Antron, cut thread and push bead up over Antron to form gills.
3. Restart thread behind bead and lay base on hook to bend.
4. Create a dubbing loop, wind thread to bead. Add sparse amount of ice dub and twist into a very tight noodle. Wind dubbing loop to bead, tie off, whip finish and cement.
5. Trim body to smooth profile. Trim gills to appropriate length.

That's it...You're done...Very easy.

**How to Fish:**

Just like any nymph, This Fly can be fished near the bottom as a second fly, mid in the column or in the film if tied without a bead. Any way you fish is the best. This fly is simple to tie, simple to fish and will attract hungry trout. Tight lines. E.
