Lt. Dan Riordan made the ultimate sacrifice while serving his country in Iraq. Others have honorably served their country and are now living among us; men who deserve, and need our support. Project Healing Waters (PHW) (<http://www.projecthealingwaters.org>) addresses their physical and emotional needs through the healing powers of fly fishing. PHW is a rapidly expanding non-profit organization headquartered in Maryland with over 50 chapters, including St. Louis.

Each year we honor Lt. Riordan and celebrate his life through a gathering of fly fisherman. We enjoy each other's friendship and raise donations in his memory. This year's event will feature a two-fly fishing contest with 50 participants and over 80 total campers – so far. The 3-day event will take place October 8-10th just outside of Montauk State Park near Salem, MO. The proceeds from the two-fly contest will go to Project Healing Waters and 50% of all the camping fee proceeds will go to the Lt. Dan Riordan Scholarship Fund at Vianney High School.
